PERC UPDATE

The City's request for modification to the Kitsap Public Facilities District InterLocal Agreement for the PERC. These modifications were approved by their board 12/14/2020:

1. We asked to extend the period of performance from 12/31/2020 to 12/31/2021. This extension is necessary because:
 - The Pandemic greatly delayed project progress in the first half of 2020.
 - Survey results have shown great community support and there is more work to be done.
2. We asked that the City be able to move funds between different tasks as needed and with the approval of the KPFD. There will be no change to the grant amount of \$243,900.

- Strong community preferences for indoor and outdoor recreation uses
- Strong sentiment to not duplicate programs and services that are already offered in the community.
- >40% of respondents are less than 6 years in their current residence





Key Takeaways

- 72% are in favor of developing private partnerships with not-for-profit agencies, such as the YMCA or Boys & Girls Club.
- 74% would be supportive or likely be supportive of a ballot measure to fund the construction costs.
- Strong community support for a public meeting/volunteerism related to the project
