WHEREAS, the ADA provides anti-discrimination protection for our nation's 61 million Americans with disabilities and recognizes their right to be integral, contributing, productive and valued community members of our country and state; and

WHEREAS, people with disabilities are an irreplaceable resource, and we cannot morally or financially afford to lose the contributions that this untapped workforce brings, not only to the workplace, but also to mainstream community life; and

WHEREAS, the City of Poulsbo, in partnership with Kitsap County and other public agencies, and with the cooperative assistance of numerous civic and non-profit groups, can look forward to a continued expansion of employment opportunities for the greater acceptance of people with disabilities in the competitive labor market; and

WHEREAS, by joint resolution, the United States Congress has designated October as National Disability Employment Awareness Month; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rebecca Erickson, Mayor of the City of Poulsbo, Washington, do hereby proclaim October 2024, as:
