## RESOLUTION NO. 2026-03

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON SUSPENDING PARKING ENFORCEMENT FOR REPARKING WITHIN THE DOWNTOWN PARKING ENFORCEMENT AREA FOR TWELVE MONTHS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Poulsbo City Council has established parking regulations pursuant to Poulsbo Municipal Code (“PMC”) Chapter 10.12; and

**WHEREAS**, PMC Section 10.12.050 prohibits a vehicle from being reparked on either side of the same street in a restricted time zone in order to extend the vehicle’s parking time beyond the time limits established; and

**WHEREAS**, the Poulsbo City Council has adopted new parking time limits and a parking enforcement program in the downtown core in order to improve parking management, accessibility, and overall functionality of the area; and

**WHEREAS**, implementation of a new parking program often involves a transition period during which residents, visitors, and businesses become familiar with updated parking rules, signage, payment systems, and enforcement practices; and

**WHEREAS**, temporarily suspending enforcement of the reparking prohibition within the downtown parking and enforcement area (Exhibit A) will allow the public additional time to understand and adapt to the new parking requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that a twelve-month suspension of the reparking prohibition during this transition period is in the public interest and will support the successful implementation of the new downtown parking program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**


**Section 1. Findings.** The Poulsbo City Council hereby adopts the foregoing recitals as findings in support of this Resolution.

**Section 2. Suspension of PMC Section 10.12.050; Sunset Clause.** The Poulsbo City Council hereby suspends enforcement of PMC Section 10.12.050 for a period of twelve months. This suspension will terminate on or before March 18, 2027, unless the City Council takes action to extend or otherwise terminate the suspension sooner.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Poulsbo City Council.


