



NOTICE OF UPCOMING ROADWORK

THE CITY OF POULSBO WILL BE DOING A ROADWAY PROJECT IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD, SUMMER 2026

To preserve the quality of the roadway the City of Poulsbo will be doing a roadway preservation project in your neighborhood.

The type of preservation treatment we will be using is called Scrub Seal.

Scrub Seal treatment involves the application of asphalt emulsion followed by a layer of crushed rock that is swept into small cracks over the roadway. The asphalt emulsion and crushed rock cure, which is then followed by an application of fog seal which is a light coat of asphalt emulsion.

Several roads will be receiving a Fog Seal Only. These roads are in good condition and we want to seal them to help preserve them. See map for details

REASONS FOR SCRUB SEAL

- The roads in your neighborhood have deteriorated over time. There is cracking throughout that allows water into the subgrade. Keeping water out of the subgrade of the roadway helps preserve the life of the existing asphalt for many years.
- Scrub Seal preserves and seals the entire roadway forcing emulsion into the cracks and sealing the road. A small layer of gravel will be placed on top to add some structural integrity. Finally, the entire roadway will have a layer of Fog Seal sprayed over it to help hold the rocks in place and give the road a uniform black appearance.
- The scrub seal is a cost-effective method to extend the life of the paved roadway.

WHAT THIS MEANS TO YOU

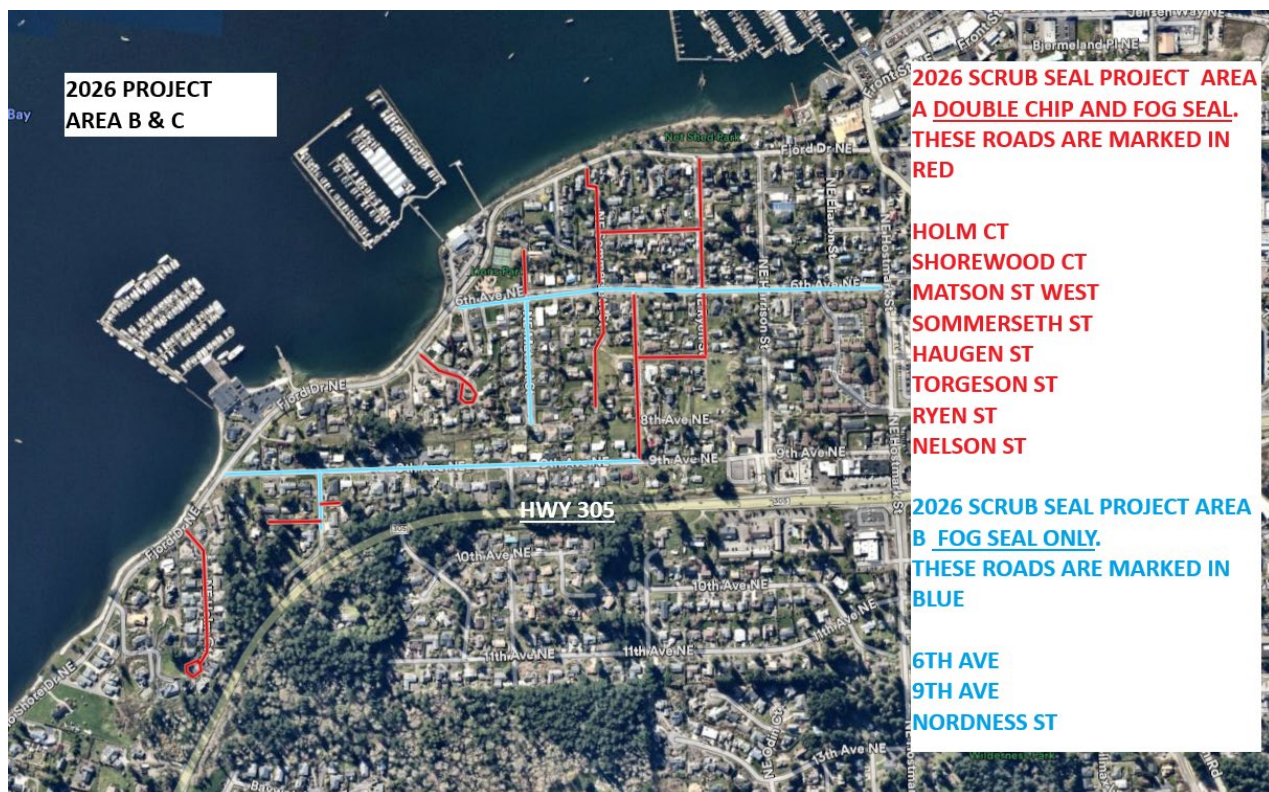
- During construction the roadways will be shut down to traffic during the day to place the material and let it dry. The closures will be kept to a minimum to try to accommodate both the work that needs to be done and the impact on the residents. You will be able to access your homes by the end of each workday.

- During these closures, you will not be able to access your homes by vehicle. The material will need to be completely cured to prevent it being tracked into your driveway.
- The work is weather dependent, and one street would typically be completed in a couple of days. You will be notified a couple weeks in advance of the work in your neighborhood and informed of the work on your street 48 hours in advance.
- This project is funded by the City of Poulsbo Neighborhood Streets program.

- The project is currently out to bid.
- Currently we do not have the exact dates and time for each development, however we are planning for August to Early September.
